Our silver polyfoil packets are heat-sealed to preserve freshness. Smaller sizes are resealable with a convenient ziplock closure. When ordering the largest-size packets (-H and -K), we recommend dispensing a portion of the tea into a small canister, which can serve for daily use. Select teas are also offered in a plug-top, British-style tea tin (-T). We suggest ordering only the amount of tea that will be consumed in three to six months.

We will gladly personalize your tea packet with your name or the name of your gift recipient. This personalization is free of charge and adds a wonderful personal touch to your tea.

Derived from plant-based starch, our packaging "peanuts" are 100% biodegradable in warm water or your compost. Our boxes are made from 100% recycled material.

The golden-amber cup is buttery smooth, filling the palate with classic floral notes that are enhanced by hints of honey and corn silk. Originally planted in 1869, the venerable Seeyok Estate is located near the India-Nepal border and sits at an altitude averaging 4,700 feet, with a scenic view of Kanchenjunga Mountain, the third-highest peak in the world. In this superlative 2024 first flush Darjeeling TD240S offering, flecks of bright green leaves and silver tips thread through Sample bold, olive-green leaves, which produce a mouth-filling cup of golden sunshine. The sweet aroma is fragrant with notes of honey and meadow flowers, complemented by a fresh vegetal hint. The smooth liquor exhibits a lively, spring-like character, with floral notes that are accented by a nuance of oak. The crisp, pungent finish is well balanced with a lingering honey sweetness.

SUNGMA ESTATE FIRST FLUSH FTGFOP1 FLOWERY (2025 DJ-12) DARJEELING

With elevations ranging from 3,500 to 5,500 feet, the esteemed Sungma Estate was first planted in the 1860s. This 2025 first flush selection offers a creamy, mouth-filling cup with a sugary-sweet, toasty aroma that hints at almond and anise. The amber-gold liquor presents a classic floral bouquet, enhanced by a tropical fruit sweetness. The refreshing finish lingers with a floral aftertaste that adds depth to the flavor profile.

THURBO ESTATE FIRST FLUSH FTGFOP1 CL (2025 DJ-22) DARJEELING Producing premium Darjeeling teas in the Mirik Valley for over a century, the Thurbo Estate cultivates tea at an average elevation of 6,000 feet. In this 2025 first flush offering, silver tips are sprinkled TD256S among attractive leaves in shades of olive green. Tropical fruit Sample notes lend a rich sweetness to both the aroma and the amber-gold cup. Hints of fresh corn silk and spring greens add depth to the fragrance. A candy-like sweetness complements subtle notes of almond and flowers in the flavor. The crisp finish lingers with the whisper of a spring garden.

THURBO ESTATE FIRST FLUSH FTGFOP1 CL (2024 DJ-13) DARJEELING This impressive 2024 first flush selection is from the Thurbo Estate, which is located in the verdant Mirik Valley of Darjeeling. The well-made, attractive leaves yield a golden-amber liquor, TD239S aromatic with a floral essence, a pronounced sweetness, and a Sample fresh vegetal hint. The medium-bodied cup has a lively character, \$4.00 bursting with rich floral notes, a tropical fruit whisper, and a hint of mineral. The subtly crisp, lingering finish leaves a pleasant sweetness on the palate, completing an enjoyable tea experience.

A Fragrant Fusion of Flavor and Tradition

Tea has long been revered not only as a comforting beverage but also as a deeply rooted cultural ritual across continents. For centuries, the act of steeping and sipping tea has been intertwined with moments of rest, conversation, and ceremony. Yet, in recent years, its nuanced flavors have found new life beyond the teacup, emerging in kitchens as a prized ingredient for baking. From the brothy depth of Matcha to the citrus lift of Earl Grey, tea brings a distinctive complexity that transforms a simple treat into an aromatic experience. This convergence of baking and tea invites both novice and seasoned bakers to explore a world where fragrance, flavor, and history meld seamlessly. To embrace tea as an essential pantry staple is to wrap each tea-infused treat in a story of terroir, tradition, and taste.

Whether you're crafting a batch of rich sweets with a black or green tea or experimenting with herbal infusions in a delicate pastry, tea is a deeply expressive and versatile ingredient. It encourages bakers to slow down, to savor the process, and to honor centuries of craftsmanship in every bite.

Incorporating tea into baking is more than a modern culinary trend; it's an extension of how tea has historically permeated cuisine. In Japanese culture, for instance, green tea has been used dating back to the Edo period (1603–1868) not just in ceremonial tea preparation but also in the preparation of *ochazuke*, which translates to "submerged in tea" or "tea over rice." A classic comfort food, *ochazuke*, involves pouring green

tea over rice, which is then topped with various savory ingredients such as green onions, toasted sesame seeds, nori (seaweed), and umeboshi (pickled plum).

One of the earliest and most enduring associations between tea and baked goods arose in Britain with the creation of "afternoon tea" in the 1840s. Popularized by Anna Russell, Duchess of Bedford, the ritual provided a solution to the long gap between lunch and a late dinner. The table would be set with teapots, bread and butter, and an array of small cakes and pastries, cementing the pairing of tea and baked treats in the public imagination.

Tea cakes themselves have a rich lineage. A notable example is the Edenton Tea Party Cakes. These simple, sweet cakes were famously served in 1774 in Edenton, North Carolina, during the Edenton Tea Party, part of a landmark political protest against the British Tea Act of 1773. Led by Penelope Barker, 51 women gathered to renounce imported British tea, serving instead these cakes with locally sourced herbal infusions. It remains one of the earliest recorded organized political actions by women in America, underscoring how tea, even when absent from the cup, has been a symbol of identity, resistance, and community.

In Ireland, Barmbrack (from the Irish: báirín breac, meaning "speckled loaf") is a traditional fruit bread that dates back to the 19th century. Dried fruit pieces freckle every slice of this delicious loaf. This gave rise to Tea Brack, which refers to the practice, likely emerging in the early to mid-20th century, of soaking the dried fruit in cold tea overnight, before adding it to the batter. Today, tea continues to inspire bakers across the globe. Green tea, particularly Matcha, lends its vivid hue and umami-rich complexity to cakes, brownies, and scones. Matcha's fine powder folds seamlessly into batters and doughs. Black teas, from malty Assam to aromatic Earl Grey, are equally versatile. Earl Grey's lively bergamot notes pair beautifully with creamy frostings, cakes, and breads. Chai, with its medley

of spices, can be infused into milk or butter to create warmly spiced cookies or donuts.

Two approachable methods for incorporating tea into baked goods are infusion and direct incorporation. Infusion involves steeping loose leaf tea in water, milk, cream, or melted butter to impart flavor to a liquid or fat component before it is mixed into the recipe. For example, infusing cream with tea creates a fragrant base for a sweet confection. Direct incorporation, on the other hand, works best with powdered teas like Matcha or finely ground black tea, which can be whisked directly into dry ingredients like flour. This method delivers a more pronounced flavor as well as visible flecks of tea throughout the baked item.

The growing interest in culinary tea craft also echoes a broader cultural embrace of tea's health benefits. From polyphenol antioxidants that help combat oxidative stress to the calming amino acid *L-theanine*, tea offers functional advantages alongside its sensory appeal.

As more bakers discover the versatility of tea, it becomes clear that this venerable leaf provides a nearly infinite wealth of flavor combinations to excite the modern palate.

A rich and earthy twist on the classic brownie, these Matcha Brownies blend the bittersweet depth of unsweetened chocolate with the vibrant, grassy notes of our Culinary Matcha Organic (page 27). See recipe on next page.

Matcha Brownies

- ½ cup (1 stick) unsalted butter
- · 2-3 oz unsweetened baking chocolate, chopped
- ¾ cup granulated sugar
- ¼ cup brown sugar (adds a subtle caramel note)
- 2 large eggs (for extra richness, add 1 egg yolk)
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ½ cup all-purpose flour
- 2 tablespoons TJ86: Culinary Matcha Organic (page 27)
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F. Line an 8x8 pan with parchment paper.
- In a heatproof bowl, melt the butter and baking chocolate together over a saucepan of barely simmering water, stirring until smooth (or use short microwave bursts).
- 3. Add both sugars and whisk until glossy.
- 4. Beat in the eggs and yolk, one at a time, then stir in the vanilla. Mix until smooth.
- In a separate bowl, whisk together the flour, Matcha, and salt. Gently fold this into the wet mixture with a spatula. Do not overmix.
- 6. Spread evenly into the prepared pan.
- 7. Bake 20-25 minutes, until the edges are set and an inserted toothpick comes out clean.
- 8. Cool in the pan, then chill in the fridge for 30 minutes. Cut into squares.

Fragrant with ginger and finished with a delicate vanilla tea glaze, these scones offer a simple, soothing twist on a classic teatime treat.

Ginger Cream Scones with Vanilla Glaze

GINGER CREAM INFUSION:

- 1 cup heavy cream
- 2 tablespoons BH15: Ginger Root Superior Organic (page 36)
- 1. Combine heavy cream and 2 tablespoons BH15: Ginger Root Superior Organic.
- 2. Over low heat, warm gently to a bare shimmer, then turn off the heat.
- 3. Cover and steep for 20-30 minutes.
- 4. Press the cream through a fine-mesh strainer and cool completely in the fridge.

SCONES:

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 tablespoon baking powder
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- 2-4 tablespoons sugar (depending on desired sweetness)
- · Optional: candied ginger
- 1. Preheat oven to 400°F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
- 2. Whisk the flour, baking powder, salt, and sugar in a large bowl.
- 3. If desired, add candied ginger.
- 4. Pour the cold ginger cream into the dry mix and stir until a shaggy dough forms.
- 5. Gently knead the dough on a floured surface. Pat into a circle, 1 inch thick.
- 6. Cut into 8 pie-shaped wedges.
- 7. Bake 15-18 minutes until golden on the edges.
- 8. Cool and glaze.

VANILLA TEA GLAZE:

- 2 teaspoons NF90: Vanilla Black Tea (page 33)
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- Optional: ½ teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1. Pour ¼ cup of boiling water over the tea and steep for 5 minutes. Strain and cool.
- In a glass measuring cup, whisk the powdered sugar. Slowly stir in the vanilla tea, starting with 2 tablespoons and adding more until desired consistency.
- 3. If desired, stir in vanilla extract for a stronger vanilla flavor.
- 4. Spoon, brush, or drizzle the glaze over the scones. Set for 10-15 minutes.

Chai Spiced Donuts

TEA CONCENTRATE:

- 4 tablespoons BH33: Chai Namaste Organic (page 36)
- In a small saucepan, bring 2 cups of water to a gentle boil. Add BH33: Namaste Chai Organic and reduce the heat to low.
- 2. Simmer 8-10 minutes, uncovered.
- 3. Pour through a fine-mesh strainer into a heat-safe measuring cup, removing all chai spice pieces.
- 4. Return the strained tea to the saucepan and simmer over low heat for 20-30 minutes (depending upon stove and pot size), stirring occasionally, until the liquid measures ½ cup. Check at 10 minutes, then every 5 minutes. The flavor will become more concentrated as the liquid reduces.
- 5. Cool the concentrate for 10 minutes before adding to your recipe.

DONUTS:

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- ¾ teaspoon baking powder
- 3 teaspoons BH33: Chai Namaste Organic, finely ground (use more for a bolder chai spice flavor)
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- · 2 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted
- 1 large egg, room temperature
- ½ cup packed light or dark brown sugar
- ½ cup granulated sugar
- 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- ¼ cup milk
- ¼ cup sour cream
- · Special kitchen supply: Donut pan
- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F. Coat the donut pan with nonstick spray. Set aside.
- In a large bowl, whisk together the dry ingredients: flour, baking soda, baking powder, BH33: Chai Namaste Organic (finely ground), and salt.

- In a separate medium bowl, whisk the melted butter, egg, brown sugar, granulated sugar, vanilla extract, milk, and sour cream until well combined.

- 6. Spoon the batter into the donut pan, filling each cavity about halfway.

- 8. Cool the donuts in the pan for several minutes, then transfer to a wire rack.
- 9. Lightly re-grease the pan and bake the remaining batter.

TOPPING:

- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 3 teaspoons BH33: Chai Namaste Organic, finely ground
- 6 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted

In a medium bowl, combine the sugar and finely ground BH33: Chai Namaste Organic. Once the donuts are cool enough to handle, dunk both sides in melted butter, then generously coat in the chai-sugar mixture.

TEA NOMENCLATURE



One of the most frequently asked questions that we receive is: "What does the string of letters listed after the name of my favorite tea mean?" Our Valued Customers have long requested that we include an explanation in our quarterly catalog to decode the enigmatic "tea nomenclature," and we are glad to oblige.

Due to a lack of information on the subject, there is great confusion over one of the simplest of tea terms: OP (Orange Pekoe). Contrary to popular opinion, Orange Pekoe does not refer to a particular flavor, or even to a specific variety or quality of tea. Orange Pekoe is nothing more than a designation of leaf size.

As a result of the manufacturing process, the final product is composed of leaf particles of varying sizes. Because the finer particles steep quickly, the tea is sifted into lots of uniform leaf sizes. Teas designated OP are composed of larger leaf particles or whole leaves that will not pass through a sieve of a particular gauge. BOP (Broken Orange Pekoe) designates a grade that is finer than OP. Grades finer than BOP are called fannings, (PF for Pekoe Fannings), and the smallest particles are referred to as dust. Dust grades are used primarily in teabags.

Other letters are often appended to the grade of tea to produce a baffling list of designations, such as SFTGFOP1 (Super-Fine Tippy Golden Flowery Orange Pekoe, grade 1). While there is a general correlation between acronyms and the general appearance and character of the tea, there is no strict correlation between the acronyms and the value or flavor of the tea. While these lengthy acronyms appear on nearly every chest of single-estate tea, the real value of the tea is in its appeal to the palate.
